Death of L. B. Peck, 5 wec 1895 (Lutner Berton Peck) fnat long time and popular citizen of Anamosa, Iowa, L. s. Seck native of Susquenanna County, Pennsylvania. Was born 20 February 1837. His earlier years were spent on a farm. He graduated from the business college at Bingnamton, New York, became a school teacher and had charge of a number of schools in Susquehanna county. In 1861 he came to Iowa and lived at Marion, where he was employed by his uncle, Henry Welch, a wealthy farmer. Three years later he removed to Anamosa and became a dealer in general merchandise, which avocation he followed until 1873. During President Cleveland's first administration he was railway postal clerk between Anamosa and Clinton, and filled the offices of city assessor and city clerk a number of terms. In 1807 ne was married to Miss Annie Gray, who survives him. Five children were born to this union; denry L, foreman of the Cascade Fioneer newspaper; John who lives in Calhan, Colo, Ars D. w. (Bertha) Ellis; fyrus and Stella of Anamosa. Ine Funeral was held at the family residence, Rev Heald or the Methodist society officiated.
