We are now 2 years old! 1900 was a productive year for the society. Marriage books "A" and "B" have been published and Book "F" is being assembled. Due to the material in this book being more complicated and more information is given book "F" will not be ready for publication until later this year. The committee has started on Book "C". The resource center in the Anamosa Art and Tole Store is growing. There have been several generous donations of books and other material. The collection includes books of local interest, (not always just Jones County) family group sheets, pedigree charts, newspaper clippings and cemetery lists.

Work is progressing on the recording of the names from the stones and charting of the cemeteries. We could use volunteers to work on this project. The book MAY be ready for the publisher in 1909.

Col. Shaw returned a few days ago from a visit to Maine, his native state.

WILLIAM TUCKERMAN SHAW

Born 22 Sept 1822 Steuben, Washington Co. Maine, son of Wm. N. and Nancy Stevens Shaw. He went to Kentucky as a teacher and enlisted in the 2nd RI infantry Regiment in the Mexican War. In 1849 he was leader of the 1st party which crossed the plains to California from Ft. Smith Ar, via Santa Fe. There were thirty six men accompanying him. Wm. came to Jones Co. in 1853 and settled in Anamosa. In 1861 he was elected Colonel of the 14th Ia. Infantry. Returned to Anamosa after the civil War and engaged in farming, banking, railroading, and the real estate business.

Olin was named for D.A. Olin, general superintendent of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul railroad. Olin was first called Elkford, then Walnut Fork, home and now Olin.

3 June 1860, Sunday, A tornado ripped through Jones County. W. Allen, Mrs. Allen, 3 children and John Niles were killed. In Greenfield Township, Charles Robinsons house was blown apart. Andrew Pettit lost his house. School houses in subdistricts 6 and 4 were destroyed William Kohl lost his house and barn.. G. W. Lattimer's house blown down. Jacob Cole lost his house and two of his children were injured. E. M. Nickerson, M.H. Nickerson and Isaac Staffy all lost their homes. In Home Township Mr. Piper lost his House and 2 children were killed, Elisna Miller's 12 year old son was killed and Samuel Cook who lived with the millers was injured. The houses of Mr. Scoles, Wm. May, and Wm. Brockelhurst were destroyed.
