The Eureka/Anamosa Eureka Scrapbook at the Anamosa Library "DEATH OF A JONES COUNTY BOY, Corporal Wm. J. Rudisill, of company C, 49th lowa, died of typhoid fever at Havana, Cuba, March 28th. The remains were sent to Cedar Rapids where his parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. W. Rudisill, reside. The funeral services were held on Monday, conducted by Rev. J. M. Rudy, of the Christian Church, assisted by Dr. Green, and the burial was with military honors. The deceased was a young man of of the highest character and the universal esteem entertained for him was evinced by the large concourse of veterans, Co. C members and those who previously belonged to that company and citizens generally. Mr. Rudisill was a grandson of the late John Rudisill, well known among the pioneers of Highland Grove. He was born in Olin and was about 22 years of age..."



"Elizabeth D. Perryman. of Amber. Iowa, died at the home of her daughter in Chicago, Ill., Jan. 23, 1896, aged 70 years. She was born in Queensbury, N.B., in 1826. She was married in 1847 to Luke Perryman, who preceded her to the spirit world seventeen years. Six children were born to them, all of whom survive her and mourn their loss. She came to Jones county thirty-seven years ago and settled on a farm near Amber. She joined the M. E. church on probation four years ago and lived a bouyant, trustful life. She was a good neighbor, careful of her words, that she might not offend the finest sensitive feeling. She was well known and highly regarded, and her friends observed with sorrow her failing strength.

She was visiting her daughter in Chicago when she was taken sick, and gradually failed, till the vital cord gave way and she fell asleep. She was unconscious the last three days of life, till just before the end came, when she rallied, knew her friends, bade them all good-bye and died peacefully.

She was brought back to Amber for burial. The funeral services were held at the M. E. church at Amber on Sunday, Jan. 26, 1896, at 2 o'clock p. m., Rev. J. N. Blodgett conducting them assisted by Dr. A. S. Palmer. A large congregation assembled and followed her to the cemetery and laid her away to rest. J. N. Blodgett."
