Genealogy of the Shotwell family in the United States begins in 1665, when Abraham Shotwell, of Quaker descent, emigrated from England and located at Elizabeth, N. J. were discontinued.

Otis Siver was married on Jan. 21, 1915, to Fern Tallman, daughter of Will Tallman of Morley. They had two sons: Glenn and Floyd. They bought a farm west of the White Oak church in 1917. Mrs. Siver died in Jan., 1962. Mr. Siver still resides on the farm and raises

John, the second of the Allen Siver family, was married in 1917 to Grace Kohl, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Kohl. They were the parents of two daughters: Velma and Janette.
