OBITUARY.

Died, at his residence in Wayne township, Dec. 30, 1891, John McBride, in the 76th year of his age. The deceased was born Nov. 25, 1816, at or near Youngstown, Ohio, and had just passed his 75th birthday. In 1857 he came west and settled in Wayne township, of which he was a continuous resident up to the time of his death. He was married in 1842 to Ann Nelson, the mother of I. N. McBride, who died in the service of his country at Memphis, Tenn. His first wife died in 1847. In December of 1848 the deceased was united in marriage to Isabella Craig. Isabella Craig McBride was the mother of the two surviving members of the family, John C. and James McBride. Isabella Craig McBride died in 1857. In November, 1859, John McBride was married to Mary Jane Nelson, who died in 1883. At an early age, before he was 21, the deceased united with the Associate Reformed church and all through his life he was a humble follower of Jesus Christ. When he came west to Iowa he identified himself with the U. P. church, of East Wayne. Thus through a long life, through sorrow and joy, through all the shifting scenes of this life, he had a firm faith in God.

The funeral services, on account of the inclemency of the weather, were held at the house. In the absence of Rev. C. C. Potter, the services were conducted by Rev. Robinson, of Scotch Grove. Thus one by one the old landmarks pass away; but thanks be to God who giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

—Mr. E. J. Gill, one of the guards at the prison, was a sergeant major in the 58th Illinois, was captured the 6th of April, 1862, at Shiloh, taken to a prison pen in Tuscaloosa, Alabama, thence to another at Montgomery, thence to a third in Macon, Georgia, and finally to Libby. In November of the same year he was exchanged and reached home on Thanksgiving day a mere skeleton, had a shake of the ague and could not eat a mouthful of turkey. Mr. Gill can tell some very interesting incidents of prison life.

—The remains of Mr. Mark Wetherell, buried at the poor farm January 13, 1890, were taken up December 31, brought to Anamosa and placed by the side of his mother.

Austin WELCH and his wife Margaret MELIA, brother-in-law Michael ENGLISH, his wife Honora [Hannah] MELIA, and their families came to America from Ireland in 1851. They first settled in Marcellus, Onondaga County New York.

Austin was in Jones County by 12 May 1868 when he bought the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Sec. 25 and the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 Sec. 24 of Township 85 and the S 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 24 Township 85 Range 1.

Austin's children were Gregory WELCH, John B. WELCH, Michael WELCH, Thomas WELCH, Bridget WELCH, Austin WELCH, Henry WELCH, Patrick WELCH, Martin WELCH, Maggie WELCH and Mary WELCH.

Austin and his wife, and Michael ENGLISH'S family were all buried at St. Peter's, Temple Hill, Cascades Iowa.

Gregory WELCH remained in Onondaga Co., New York. John B. WELCH lived in Connecticut, and then in Columbia, Boone Co. MO where he established the Welch Military Academy. Michael WELCH moved from Iowa to Stanberry, Gentry Co. MO. I do not know the history of Austin WELCH Jr. Henry WELCH moved from Jones Co. to Stanberry, Gentry Co. Mo around 1901 with his wife Mary Ellen READE. Patrick WELCH and wife Susie MORAN moved to Montana and later to Spokane WA, where he was very successful in buying land for the railroad. Martin WELCH also moved west and worked for the railroad. Maggie WELCH married Samuel LINDSEY.

One daughter married Francis DUKE, and another daughter married Stephen K. MANNING and moved to Superior Wisconsin.

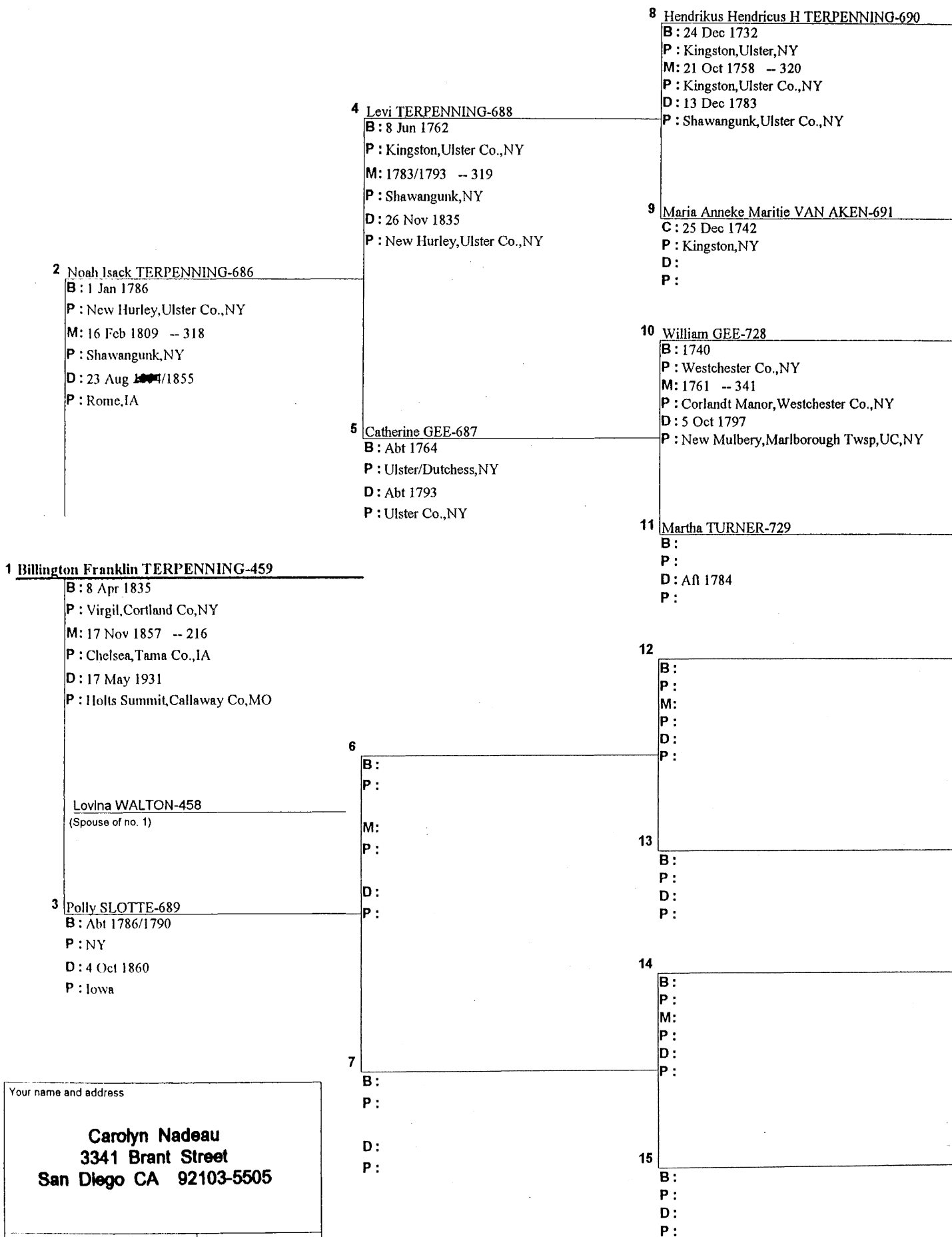
