MORE SMALLPOX IMPORTATION - The state board of health has received the following telegram from the emigrant commissioner of the port of New York: "One case of smallpox occurred aboard the steamer Karirupe, arriving April 7. The case was removed to **quarantine together with the** passengers occupying the same compartment. All precautions taken to prevent the spread of ~~the~~ disease. The following named emigrants started today for your state: Anna and Claus MOHR, Emil and Anna PETUSCH, Margretta and Josephine MOHR started for Olin IA and Fred-erick HANSEN, wife and child and Freida HANSEN started for Bellevue, IA"

Edward Dusanek Services Are Held

Edward Albert Dusanek, 53, youngest son of Mary and George Dusanek was born at Wyoming, Iowa, and passed away at Hot Springs, New Mexico, last Saturday.

He attended the country school near his home and graduated from the Wyoming school in 1916. He attended Iowa State College at Ames, enlisted in the armed forces during the school year. He was honorably discharged, and on Feb. 21, 1928, he was married to Anna Kropik of Oxford Junction, who preceded him in death, on November 25, 1940.

In December of 1940 Mr. Dusanek moved to Albuquerque, New Mexico in an effort to find relief from an asthmatic condition. He had been permanently located at Caballo, New Mexico for the past six years. He was a member of the American Legion at Wyoming, whose members assisted in burial services.

Funeral services will be held from the Methodist church in Wyoming, Rev. F. E. Somerville in charge, Paul Godfrey will sing, accompanied by Mrs. Godfrey. Interment will be in the Mayflower cemetery, Oxford Junction, the Wyoming American Legion in charge.
