SHOTWELL

Emerson and Francis J.

Genealogy of the Shotwell family in the United States begins in 1665, when Abraham Shotwell, of Quaker descent, emigrated from England and located at Elizabeth, N. J. From his descendants came the ancestral family, in direct lineage of which were the forefathers of Joseph Marsh Shotwell, Emerson Shotwell, and Francis J. Shotwell.

Joseph Marsh Shotwell was born in Canada and came to Iowa for the first time in 1854. He returned to Canada where he married Martha Ferguson, and in 1866 immigrated to Iowa, locating in Greenfield township in Jones county. He was married Oct. 24, 1923, to Eleanor Colony, a daughter of Charles E. and Mary (Moreland) Colony, of North Liberty, Iowa. They are the parents of a daughter, Shirley; and reside on and operate a 120-acre farm, the original homestead founded by Mr. Shotwell's grandfather, Joseph Marsh Shotwell, in section 21 and 22 of Greenfield township.

ALLEN (AL) SIVER

Allen Siver, when he was 17 years old in 1884, along with his older brother, Henry, came to Iowa, and for eight years were employed on various farms in the Mechanicsville-Morley area. Allen, who was better known as Al, on Feb. 26, 1891, was married to Cora Manly, daughter of Tom and Alice Manly. They started farming in the southern part of Greenfield township, and in 1894 moved to a farm they had purchased east of the White Oak church, where they made their home for 27 years.

Otis Siver was married on Jan. 21, 1915, to Fern Tallman, daughter of Will Tallman of Morley. They had two sons: Glenn and Floyd. They bought a farm west of the White Oak church in 1917. Mrs. Siver died in Jan., 1962. Mr. Siver still resides on the farm and raises ponies.

John, the second of the Allen Siver family, was married in 1917 to Grace Kohl, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Kohl. They were the parents of two daughters: Velma and Janette. They moved to the parental home farm in 1921 and remained there until 1965, when they moved to Anamosa. John Siver's death occurred in Oct. 1968.

When the John Siver family moved onto the home place in 1921, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Allen Siver with their son, Arthur, moved to Mount Vernon where their son attended school for two years. They moved from Mount Vernon in 1923 to the farm now occupied by the Siver family. The senior Mr. Siver died in Jan., 1964, at the age of 97; his widow died March 6, 1967 when she was 95 years old.
