The first settlers came from Connecticut and Massachusetts in the year 1792 and made a settlement on the Cold Brook, south of the village later called Russia. Walters and the Robins and the Millingtons and Russels came in 1799. They farmed on adjoining farms a couple of miles east of Russia.

IM C Walters came to Iowa by way of a steamer from Cleveland OH to De troit, then took the "cars" from there to Rockford. His family with relative s went on to Canton, IA by way of wagon and he stayed in Chicago waiting for a wagon to arrive. The family took the trip with a man by the name of Glidden and arrived safely at William Eckler's in October 1852. Some of the family came by way of wagons and oxen. About 1853 William Eckler and James Hall erected a dam on the Maquoketa River and built a water-power sawmill. About 1863 or 1864 Eckler and M C Walters built a steam mill which was used for a sawmill. The old water mill was then fitted up as a grist mill. James Hall and William Eckler built the first half dozen or so houses. The population at any one time was never

more than 50. M C Walters kept the first and only store, above which was the Odd Fellows Hall. On Saturday night loggers and other workers came to the store to turn in time and get cash or credit checks. There was a bolx of free tobacco and clay pipes for customers who stayed and sat a spell. Besides the usual salt and hardware the store was stocked with materials, men's shoes, etc. Deer, prairie chicken, partridge and coon were frequent fare on the table. The schoolhouse was on the north side of town established by M C and he also was the postmaster. In the Business Directory for 1882 he was listed as a grocer and sold shoes at Clayford. C A Hall was listed as constable and hald a meat market. On 10 Oct 1888 he and Mary ANewberry were married by Rev. H C asler of Cold Brook, NY. This marriage info is from Herkemer Co Hist. Society copied from newspaper article. His address in the article was Clay Mills, I a and hers, Cold Brook, NY.

They had a fire on 26 Feb 1906 and the shop was destroyed along with several other businesses in Onslow. He rebuilt the shop on the east side of Main Street and was again in business until 1910 when he moved to the SE edge of town and operated and mill and ground feed until about 1918. He lived in Onslow for some time, probably until his wife die d in 1925. He lived with his son, Purl, for some time and then moved to Dike, I A where he lived with his daughter, Adah, dying of cancer in 1936. The depression took most of his investments but he did not die penniless as my father, Purl, was given \$200 which he used as a down payment on a house at 1144 Willist on Ave. Waterloo, IA.
