ANAMOSA EUREKA: Jan 26 1865

The Advent Church at Fairview was totally consumed by fire last Tuesday. Loss \$2500.00, not covered by insurance.

At Nashville Tennessee. 4 Jan 1863 in hospital, John E Evarts of the 4th Michigan Cavalry, died age 29. At Armory Hospital, Washington D.C. Nov 1869 after suffering amputation of leg, Sergerant Edmund Evarts of Co C. 129th N.Y. Vols. died age 27 years. They were sons of Josepn and Clarinda Evarts of New Casco, Allegan Co. Michigan and formerly of Longmeadow Mass.

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WHITE OAK CHURCH

Section 22, Greenfield Twp. On a monument just outside the gate is this inscription; White Oak Church 1858-1970. This monument is in memory of Amos Kohl and other good citizens who gave of their time and gifts to erect what was known as the White Oak or Dutch Church on this site and dedicated in November of 1858. It was one of the first Evangelical Churches west of the Mississippi River. A lot of lumber was native and hand cut. A regular minister was here until 1918. The centennial was held June 9, 1968.
